JOB DESCRIPTION: Preschool Teacher

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Early Learning Center at University Baptist Church is to care for children in a loving, Christian environment while helping them to develop physically, socially, emotionally, spiritually, and cognitively.

SUPERVISION:

The teacher is supervised by and responsible to the Early Learning Center director.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Create an age-appropriate, center based, learning environment consistent with the developmental needs of children
- Develop comprehensive lesson plans based on monthly units of study involving a variety of structured and unstructured activities outlined in the curriculum
- · Instruct children according to teacher developed lesson plans
- · Evaluate the progress of children and identify areas for growth and development
- Build strong partnerships with families to connect student learning at home and school
- Communicate with the director regarding program and children's needs
- · Communicate with other teachers who may share the classroom on other days of the week
- Complete 10 hours of continuing education or training annually in the areas of child development, emergency and basic first aid, and leadership skills
- · Abide by all Early Learning Center policies and procedures

QUALIFICATIONS:

Minimum education High school diploma. Some college preferred

Minimum experience 2 years experience in group child care

Required certification CPR and First Aid, this training will be offered to new employees at the

expense of the Early Learning Center

Pre-hire review A background check will be completed and reviewed prior to hire

Physical Demands
Heavy physical effort (lift/carry 50 pounds)

Occasional standing/walkingManual dexterity and mobility

· Considerable reaching, stooping, bending, kneeling, crouching

Cognitive Demands • Plan, coordinate, and implement program activities

Communicate effectively both verbally and in writing

· Respond appropriately to emergency or crisis situations

Working Conditions • Occasional exposure to cleaning agents

· Possible exposure to blood, body fluids, or tissues
