

WORSHIP ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

**Revised 3.8.2021

As we gather for in-person worship, the UBC Staff maintains our commitment to make prayerful and informed decisions that prioritize the health and safety of others.

Do not attend if you are experiencing any of the following:

Fever, flu-like symptoms such as coughing, sore throat and fatigue, shortness of breath, or if you have been in contact with a person with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

Worship Service Options:

- We offer two worship services, one at 9:00 a.m. and one at 10:30 a.m. as long as registration numbers support both. If demand is not met, the 9:00 service will be canceled and registrants will be notified.
- Limited capacity not to exceed 20% (approx. 100 registrants, plus staff and volunteers)
- Both services will enjoy the same worship and message, however some elements in the 9:00 service may be condensed to accommodate the new timeframe.
- The 10:30 service will continue to be live streamed on the ubcfortworth.org home page, Facebook Live, YouTube and Vimeo.
- Childcare is available during both services. Registration required.

Registration:

- Registration opens on Sunday morning for the following Sunday service at ubcfortworth.org
- Please register by NOON on Saturday.
- When registering, include a count of your entire party. (Only one registration per party is necessary.)
- If you cannot register online, call 817.926.3318 ext. 119 and leave a message for Sarah Jones.
- You will be notified promptly as to whether you are approved or on the waiting list.
- Childcare registration closes at 11:59 p.m. on Thursday.

What to Expect When You Arrive:

- The South (Cantey) and East (Wabash) entrances will be open. *Please consider leaving our East entrance for those with mobility challenges and families dropping off children in the Preschool area.
- In case of inclement weather, you may enter through the North doors.
- ADA access is available at the East Preschool Porch circle drive.
- Please practice 6 ft. social distancing at all times.
 - Stay to your right when entering or exiting the building.
 - Do not congregate in doorways and/or hallways.
- If you arrive early for the 10:30 service, please wait outdoors (weather permitting) until the majority of 9:00 guests have exited the Sanctuary.
- Fellowship before and after both services will take place on the East lawn.
- Hand sanitizer is available at all entrances.
- Face coverings are still required and must be worn for the duration of the service. Masks are provided at all entrances.
- You may place your offering in the locked box in the foyer. We will not pass a plate.

Seating:

- Sit only on designated pews and maintain a 6 ft. distance between your party and others.
- At the conclusion of each service, remain seated and attendees will be dismissed in an orderly fashion.
- Please make your way out of the Sanctuary to the East Lawn to congregate rather than congregating indoors. (9:00 guests, we especially thank you for exiting quickly as we prepare for the next service.)

Restrooms:

- Guests are encouraged to use the restroom before they come to church.
- The restrooms located at the South end of the hallway and the Sanctuary foyer will be open.
- Only one person in the restroom at a time.
- Wash your hands!

SUNDAY MORNING CHILDCARE GUIDELINES

We are happy to offer childcare during worship for children ages 5 and under in compliance with our child safety and health guidelines.

- Spaces are limited (first-come, first-served)
- Registration can be found on the UBC home page: ubcfortworth.org
- Deadline to register for child care is each Thursday at 11:59 p.m.
- All children will be screened before entry.
- Drop off and screening is outdoors at the Preschool porch.
- Please be on alert for signs of illness in your children and keep them home when they are sick.

ADDITIONAL COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Positive Test of a Church Attender:

- Church services will continue but the following steps will be followed.
- All those in attendance on that day will be notified.
- We will be appropriately confidential to protect the privacy of those impacted but transparent with those who need to be made aware of any potential risk.
- Anyone who came into close contact will be encouraged to self-quarantine and monitor symptoms.
 - o Close contact would be considered if you were within the six-feet and/or weren't wearing masks and/or had any sort of direct interaction with the person that morning.
 - o Self-quarantine from a church stand point would be that you refrain from registering for the worship service again for two weeks.
- If multiple (more than one family unit) positive tests from church attenders occur on the same Sunday then the continuation of services will be evaluated.

Post-Positive COVID-19 Guidelines:

- If someone who has tested positive desires to attend a service, they should notify the pastor to inform them of their positive result and desire to attend so the following steps can be implemented.
- The individual needs to be symptom-free for at least 14 days or receive a note from a primary care physician before registering and attending a worship service or any church-related activity.
