TCU 2020 Season Parking

Where is University Baptist Church?

Our address is 2720 Wabash Avenue, Fort Worth, TX 76109. We are located on the north side of the TCU campus, just two blocks away from Amon G. Carter Stadium. We're one of the closest off-campus parking options!



How do I reserve season parking?

Easy! Register online with us, then submit your payment. Once your payment is received and processed, we'll send you a parking pass that identifies you as a season parker.

How much is a season parking pass?

\$300. And it's good for all home games in 2020.

May I pay online?

Yes! Just <u>click here</u>! Online payment will include an additional transaction fee.

You may also send us a check the old-fashioned way. Just make it payable to:

Is single-game parking available at UBC?

Season parking is our first priority. If season parkers sell out our lot, then single-game parking will not be available. If we still have space after processing all requests for season parking, then single-game parking will be available on a first-come, first-served basis for \$40/car.

May I purchase my season parking pass at the first game?

No, season parking is sold pre-season only. Registration and payment must be received by August 10, 2020, for your pass to be processed.

Is my parking fee at UBC considered tax-deductible?

No, parking provided at UBC is a service that we're happy to provide to you, and thus is not considered to be a charitable contribution.

What time does parking begin?

Our volunteers will open the lot to season parkers 3 hours prior to the posted kickoff time. Single-game parkers also will be allowed on the lot 3 hours prior to the posted kickoff time.

How do you know I'm a season parker?

We'll send you a parking pass that will easily identify you to our volunteers working the parking lot, and they will wave you right in with a smile.

Do I have an assigned/numbered parking spot?

Nope. We offer general admission season parking that guarantees you a spot, but not a specific spot. Your parking spot for the day will be assigned when you arrive.

What if I'm running late?

Our volunteers will keep the lot secure for season parkers until 15 minutes after kickoff. After that time, empty spots in our lot will be available to single-game parkers.

I need to bring a different car than usual. Can I still get in?

Absolutely! We'll issue you a parking pass that can easily be transferred from car to car, so just bring it with you when you come.

Will my car be safe at UBC?

We certainly hope so, but parking at UBC is at your own risk.

May I tailgate at UBC?

We would be happy for you to make yourself comfortable, but we do not have designated tailgating spots. You are confined to the space your vehicle occupies. If you want more space, you are welcome to buy additional parking spot(s). And, if you do choose to tailgate, we simply ask you to clean up after yourself so our lot is clean and ready for church use after the game. The use of alcoholic beverages is discouraged. Anyone not respecting the church's property will be subject to losing their parking pass for the remainder of the season. If you lose your parking privileges in the middle of the season, a refund will NOT be issued.

How late may I stay parked at UBC after the game?

In order for our lots to be ready for Sunday morning, we respectfully request that all vehicles be removed from our lot by midnight. Parked vehicles remaining on our lot will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

When is the deadline for reserving season parking?

Registration and payment must be received in our office by August 10, 2020.

What legal information should I read?

Purchaser acknowledges and agrees that only a license to park on the premises has been purchased and that no express or implied bailment has been created. Purchaser may park one vehicle in this lot at Purchaser's own risk of fire, theft or damage to vehicle or its contents.

Purchaser agrees that University Baptist Church shall not have any liability for any loss suffered by Purchaser, or Purchaser's family or guests, under the use of this license.

Acceptance of the parking pass we issue constitutes acknowledgement by Purchaser that Purchaser has read and agreed to terms of this license.

Anyone not respecting the church's property will be subject to losing their parking pass for the remainder of the season. If you lose your parking privileges in the middle of the season, a refund will NOT be issued.
